**Project Success** is a before and after-school program funded by the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Centers grant. The purpose of this program is to provide students in high poverty schools with academic enrichment opportunities along with activities to complement the regular academic program. A broad array of activities, such as youth development activities, visual art, recreation activities character education, music, dance and technology education are offered to help students meet State and local performance standards in core academic subjects such as reading and math. **Project Success** also offers families of students opportunities for literacy and related educational development.

Five (5) schools are involved in this grant: Northeast Elementary, Middle School at Parkside, Amy Firth, Jackson High School and Wilson Academy. The dedicated staff at each site (school) includes a coordinator that oversees the program. The program is in session Monday-Friday (12-15 hours/week).
